


This figure depicts a task selected on the left-hand panel, and a filtered set of framework elements on the right side. In this case, the elements on the right side are selected from the K-8 GLCE's for Math. Only elements containing a word that begins with "area", ie. elements containing "area" or "areas", are displayed. To indicate that the element on the right side aligns with the selected task on the left side, select the element in the right side, and *check* the highlighted checkbox in the *Aligns* column. Elements with "yes" in the *Aligns* column have already been aligned with the selected task. Note: <sup>1</sup>Editing of the task list will not change the elements aligned to a task; <sup>2</sup>The full text of a task for element may be displayed by positioning the mouse over the item and waiting for the tooltip to display; and, <sup>3</sup>Data entered in this view will also be reflected in the "by Framework" view, these are two different ways to enter the same data.

This figure depicts a curriculum framework element selected in the left-hand panel, and a filtered set of tasks on the right side. In this case, the framework element is from the HSCE's for ELA. Only tasks containing a word that begins with "write" or "report", ie. "write", "writes", "report", "reports", or "reporting" are displayed on the right hand side. To indicate that the task on the right side aligns with the selected element on the left side, select the task in the right side, and *check* the highlighted checkbox in the *Aligns* column. Tasks with "yes" in the *Aligns* column have already been aligned with the selected element. Note: <sup>1</sup>Editing of the task list will not change the elements aligned to a task; <sup>2</sup>The full text of a task or element may be displayed by positioning the mouse over the item and waiting for the tooltip to display; <sup>3</sup>Data entered in this view will also be reflected in the "by Task" view, these are two different ways to enter the same data; and, <sup>4</sup>Three frameworks have been merged into this document.
